While Jesus' disciples are looking for food to feed the thousands of people who hunger for Jesus, you could start following in their footsteps by looking for the words from the story about that feeding...

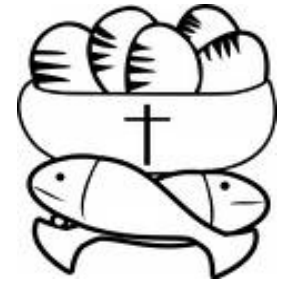

Today's lessons:

- 2 Samuel 11:1-15 When King David sees Bathsheba, the wife of one of the foreign soldiers in his army, David wants Bathsheba for himself. When Bathsheba gets pregnant from him, David comes up with an evil plot: to cover up his adultery, he sends Bathsheba's husband to his death.
- Psalm 14 In the eyes of God, all people act like fools who don't know about God: they do evil things and think they'll get away with it.
- Ephesians 3:14-21 A prayer for the Church in Ephesus and elsewhere, to grow in love and understanding of the Triune God, Father, Christ and Spirit.
- John 6:1-21 Jesus and his disciples can't escape the crowds following them. While the people are hoping to witness one of Jesus' miracles, he is concerned they might get hungry. Feeding all the 5000 of them with five loaves and two fish, he fills not only their stomachs, but also gives them food for thought.

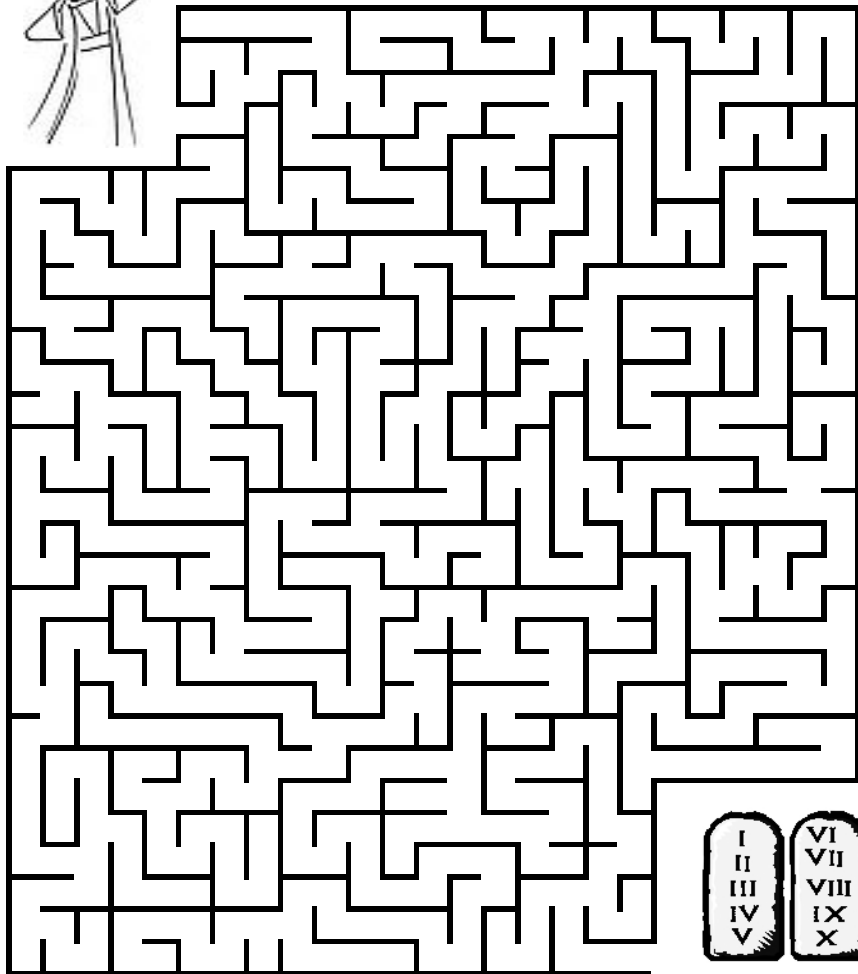
