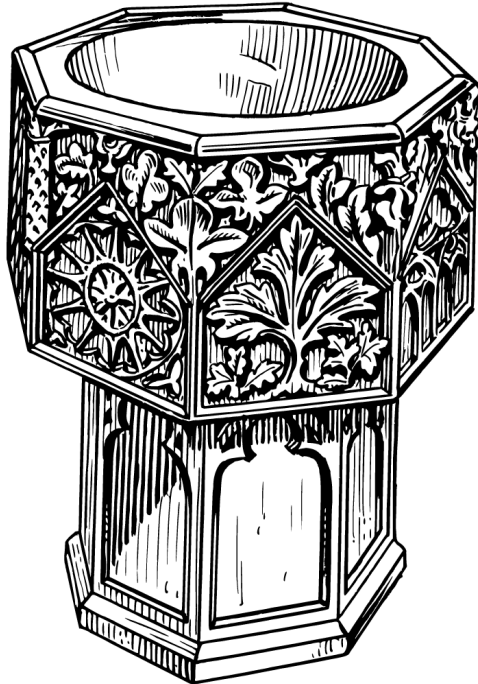

Our Parish's oldest tradition, The Pudding Factory, is making preparations for this year's pudding bake. Finished puddings and pudding pick-up, takes place this year on November 12-13.

**FINANCIAL UPDATE JANUARY-SEPTEMBER, 2022**

Year-to-date Actual Income	\$229,884
Year-to-date Budgeted Income	\$228,000
Year-to-date Actual Expenses	\$251,768
Year-to-date Budgeted Expenses	\$237,259

Notes: For the first time in quite a few years, our income is above budget. Particularly at this point in our fiscal year, this is really good news, and is in large measure due to our 2021 stewardship pledges.

At the same time, we have encountered some extraordinary and unexpected expenses for the year. Nearly all of these expenses are building related that we could not have foreseen. Thus, unfortunately, our year-to-date expenses are \$14,509 more than we had budgeted. If you are able to make a one-time contribution during the last quarter to offset our expenses, we would be most grateful.
